Casting Technologies for Weight Reduction

Tom is Vice President of Technical Services for INTERMET, where he serves on the Operating Committee. The engineering group in



Troy, the Technical Center in Lynchburg, Va. and several technical feasibility centers report to him. He joined Intermet as director, process research and development in 1999. He has over 25 years of experience in both iron and aluminum casting. Prior to joining INTERMET, he

spent over 20 years with CMI International, where he most recently was vice president of technology at CMI's Tech Center.

Tom is active in many of the metal casting technical societies. He was one of the first chairman of the ACRL steering committee and is currently serving on the ACRC steering committee. He was a past instructor at the WPI/ NTNU/SINTEF International Summer School on Shaped Aluminum castings where he spoke on the Component Design Process. He's active with the American Foundry Society where he is past-chairman of the Research Board and as the past chairman of the AFS Aluminum Division. In 1994, he received the AFS Aluminum Division Service Award and the AFS Award of Scientific Merit in 2003. He also presently serves on the NADCA Technical Advisory Group, is past-chairman of the Die Material Committee and received the 2003 Nyselius Award recognizing exceptional technical contributions to the die casting industry.

He earned B.A. and M.S. degrees in metallurgical engineering from the University of Wisconsin in Madison. He also holds three patents regarding metal casting technology.
