> Reiner Graf Technical Manager Düker Laufach, Germany

Mr. Graf graduated from the University of Duisburg in Germany with an Engineering degree in Foundry Technology. Since 1969, he has been active in the German Foundry Industry, he served many consecutive years as a President of Bavarian Region of Foundry Association. He is presently a Technical Manager at Düker, where he oversees foundry operations. Düker developed and matured the energy-saving cokeless cupola furnace with superheater. This environmentally friendly melting procedure, which works successfully in their own foundry, has roused world-wide interest.
