"Keep on Melting, Alloying and Fluxing Today" by David Williams ASI International. LTD

This month's topic will be presented by David Williams, Vice President of Technology for ASI International. Mr. Williams is a 1978 graduate of the Illinois Institute of Technology with a degree in Metallurgical Engineering. For the past thirty years he has been active in both the foundry industry and AFS. His positions in the foundry range from process metallurgist at Lebanon Steel Foundry and National Castings to Manager Product Services, Staff Metallurgist with Allied Minerals, to his current position. As a member of AFS he has served on the 8D channel furnace committee for 25 years and the 8C coreless committee for 8 vears. He has been an instructor with the Cast Metals Institute for 21 years and continues to publish and present refractory and metallurgical topics for AFS, the ACerS, the AIME/ISS, the Ductile Iron Society, Metal China and GIFA conferences and publications.

Mr. Williams' presentation will focus on new materials available to de-oxidize the molten bath without creating metallic inclusions or erosion of the contact refractory. He will outline the diverse array of newer fluxes and the benefits associated with their use.
