CMI to offer SPC Course in Birmingham

Recently the Birmingham AFS chapter surveyed membership to determine what CMI courses were needed in this area. As a result of that survey, CMI will be presenting an SPC course on February 3rd and 4th, 2009.

This class will provide a practical problem-solving approach to the control of foundry processes. Topics will include Pareto analysis, cause and effect diagrams, scatter plots, normal distributions, average and range charts, sigma charts, median charts, individual moving range charts and short run SPC techniques. Process capability considerations, including the calculation of area under normal curve, Cp and Cpk indices, will be examined.

Students are encouraged to bring to class data from their foundry.

Suggested data would be readings from sand compaction testing, pouring temperatures, core properties, such as tensile strength, Brinell harnesses for a given casting, or chemistries of an alloy. Using this data, students will be able to:

- * Improve Your Casting Quality
- * Increase Equipment Uptime
- * Enhance Productivity
- * Improve Customer Relations
- * Reduce Casting Defects
- * Bring Consistency to Your Operations
- * Determine Foundry Capabilities
- * Assist in ISO 9000 Preparation
